THE PURPOSE OF COMMUNITY

Spiritual disciplines are not ways to improve ourselves, or even to stop sinning. They are ways that we open ourselves to God's power and God's grace.

Ephesians 4.11-16 // Hebrews 3.13

Seven Ways We Minimize Sin (based on "Gospel-Centered Life" by Bob Thune)

Defending: People hesitant to approach, rarely converse about difficult things in life.

Faking: Do you try to keep up appearances and maintain a respectable image? Are you often thinking about what others think of you? Do people know the "real you"?

Hiding: Do you conceal a lot about your life, especially the "bad stuff." Where "faking" is about impressing, hiding is more about shame. Do you think people won't accept or love the "real you"?

Exaggerating: Do you tend to think (and talk) more highly of yourself than you ought?

Blaming: Are you quick to blame others for your sin or circumstances? Do you usually follow up "I'm sorry" with "but."? Pride says "it's not my fault."

Downplaying: Do you downplay your sin as "normal" or "not that bad"?

Comparing: Do you look around and justify some of your weak spots by seeing that others are doing the same or worse than yourself?
