## PRAYER

Though the Gospel itself perpetually and eternally keeps us anchored in God's grace (**Hebrews 6.13-20**), He gives us various means to keep us chained to that anchor. We could call this the difference between *union* and *communion*.

## COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Read Jeremiah 17.5-10. What stuck out to you in these verses or was the most impactful from the message on Sunday?

What is the Strategy for Life Mission Church to make disciples that make disciples? How will we do this?

Read Psalms 1:2, then read 2 Timothy 3:16, Romans 15:4, Isaiah 40:8, Psalms 18:30, Psalms 119:9-11, Psalms 119:105 and Matthew 7:24. What are some practical ways that you can set yourself up to be someone that "delights in the law of Lord", that "builds your house upon the rock" and "stores God's Word in heart?"

Read John 15:1-11 then underline, circle or highlight every time you read the word "abide". What happens when we abide?

Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-3, John 3:16-17, 1 Peter 2:24, 3:18, Romans 3:23-24, 5:8, 6:23, 2 Corinthians 5:21, Romans, and Ephesians 2:4-10. How does simply starting with recounting the truths and promises of God change the way you go to God in prayer? How does starting your prayers with the reminder of the Gospel change what you ask for? Or how you repent?

Who are you accountable to? Meaning, who are you currently "Fight Clubbing" with? Who truly knows you at Life Mission Church? Does the relationship point you to Jesus? Does this person direct you to the Gospel? Who do you regularly confess sin to? Do you have someone that can "put on the armor" for you when it's too heavy and you are to weak? Share the answer with the group.\_\_


What do you delight in? What's brings you the most joy? And what do you spend most of your free time doing?
