ATTITUDE TOWARDS OTHERS

Signs We're Expecting Too Much of Others:

Major on external issues (focus on keeping rules and expectations)
Excessive control (lots of rules, policies. Rigid expectations on spouses, kids (helicopter parenting, being overbearing or over-protective), "babysitting" or nagging friends, talking down or being smug and condescending.
Overbearing to failure (other parenting is babysitting back package).

3. Overreacting to failure (often resulting in taking back control)

4. Being unforgiving and impatient

5. Elevating personal preference over (or alongside) biblical principle

6. Unnecessary separatism (hiding, living in a bubble, asceticism)

7. Judging others (looking down on others' practices)

8. Being "belligerent" (combative with your views)

9. No sense of humor (you take yourself, and every matter, far too seriously)

Pharisees make disciples, but they make disciples of their own selves. They make followers of legalism and drudgery.

James 3.9-12

ATTITUDE TOWARDS OURSELVES

Signs of Internal Legalism:

 Guilt Trips and Pity Parties (making people feel bad if they don't do what you want; manipulation; passive aggressive words and body language; sob stories; silent treatment)
Hide Behind Scripture (take Scripture out of context to get what they want)

3. People Pleasing (care too much about what others think; want to be liked by everyone; try to always say the right thing to please someone; fear letting others down)

4. Getting validation and value from being useful (value and self-worth comes from what you do for others, being thanked, being recognized; comparing yourself to others (as parents, other marriages, ministry, talent, etc.)

5. Getting value from being needed (set up relationships in ways to be needed. Feel out of control or worthless if you are no longer needed).

HOW TO ESCAPE THIS BODY OF LEGALISTIC DEATH

ABC's of Freedom from Legalism

A: Admit and Confession. First confess to God that you have been trusting in yourself and looking elsewhere for value. Confess and admit to those you have affected. Don't do this to get sympathy.

B: Believe that the blood of Christ covers every sin. Believe that your legalism and self-righteousness has been paid for.

C: Commit to pressing the truth of the Gospel into you every day. Reach out to others. Humble yourself. Let others speak into your life. Memorize Scripture.

COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Read through **Matthew 23:1-39**. What was most impactful from the Sermon on Sunday or stuck out to you in these verses?

Re-read James 3:9-12. What areas of your life do you see hypocrisy most taking place? Is it in your parenting, marriage, workplace or friendships? Or all of the above?

In your own experience, how has your hypocrisy affected relationships and what does that do in reflecting the love of Christ?

When Jobey asked us to think about this honestly, deep down, do you aim help people to find freedom in Christ to become their own person in Christ, or do you want them to model and copy you, your values, your convictions, your preferences or your ideology." What came to mind?

Look at the sermon notes. In the first two lists, what sticks out to you as something that you know you need to admit and repent of and hopefully see change in? What drives you to do those things?

Read **Romans 2:1-5.** What leads men to repentance? Our rules and expectations or God's kindness and mercy shown through the Cross? Discuss or share with the group any experiences you may have concerning God's kindness and its power.


Read **Ephesians 4:32** and **1 Peter 4:7-8**. How are we, the body of Christ, to display God's glory?

Before you meet with your **Community Group**, take time to ask others to honestly give you some answers and feedback based on some of the items in the list. Be willing to hear what they have to say, giving them permission to speak honestly and candidly. Ask them, also, if they are afraid to be honest with you, or if they truly feel comfortable.

Take some time this week to repent of your own hypocrisy and legalism and ask the Spirit of God to show you how you are to display God's grace and kindness to those around you. Spend time at Group sharing what the Lord is showing you, asking them to help you. Spend time as a Group praying in the **P.R.A.Y.** model that Jesus gives us in **Matthew 6**.
