THE ELUSIVE PURSUIT OF CONTENTMENT

Philippians 4.10-13

CONTENTMENT

This section of Scripture has a verse that is used out of context possibly more than any other verse in the bible. Paul tells the Philippians, "I can do all things through Him who strengthens me." While this is most often used as a "power of positive thinking" type of dig deep, reach down inside and pull out an improbable victory in life type of a self-muttering, it is actually about something far more important and powerful: contentment.

Paul is thanking the church for their desire to be generous towards him, but he wants to be clear that in his thanks he is not wanting them to think that he was silently complaining or expressing neediness. He had already learned the secret of contentment.

HOW TO NOT FIND CONTENTMENT

2 Corinthians 12.8-10 // 1 Timothy 6.6-8

Contentment is the direct fruit of having no higher ambition than to belong to the Lord at His disposal.

Christian contentment is that sweet, inward, quiet, gracious frame of spirit, which freely submits to and delights in God's wise and fatherly disposal in every condition.

THE SECRET TO CONTENTMENT

Three Things that Discontentment Reveals:

- 1. Lack of Thankfulness
- 2. Arrogance
- 3. Greed and Lust (Hebrews 13.5, 6)

The secret to battling discontentment is found in **Philippians 4.13:** I can do all things through him who strengthens me." What "all things" is Paul talking about? He is speaking about contentment. But this contentment must come from the strength of God.

Faith, like anything good, is a gift of God.

Lacking faith and having no strength is an opportunity for us to glory in Christ. To depend on Him, to be reminded that we are not Him, but that He is a gracious God who takes care of us. It cause us to marvel at Him even more, that *even* when we are faithless, He remains faithful, and then He *gives us* the faith we need.

When You are Discontent, Do These Five Things:

- 1. Stop: Stop complaining, stop surfing the web, stop thinking of what you don't have.
- 2. Look: What are you looking at? What are you beholding? Name the prize you're after.
- 3. Think: Where did you get off track? Where has your mind and heart gone astray?
- 4. Confess: Speak to God, admit that you have believed a lie.
- 5. Thank: Thank Him for the Good News of Jesus, His mercy, love, and care.

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COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Before your group starts, is there anyone who can share the Memory Verse?

Read Philippians 4:10-13. Take some time and discuss what God revealed to you through His Word and the sermon on Sunday?

Re-Read 1Timothy 6:6-8 and then read Isaiah 40:8. Think about where you find contentment and share with the group. What happens to the things in this world in which we place our hope?

If we understand that being content is trusting God in all circumstances, that He knows what is best, why do our hearts continue to seek after temporary things for temporary satisfaction or relief? What needs to happen? Read Romans 12:2.

What are some ways we can grow in our contentment? Read Colossians 3:1-2. How can we as a church body help one another be content in all circumstances? Read Hebrews 3:13.

It is interesting that the enemy has great way of convincing us to expect more from God, like He's holding something back from you. Think about Adam and Eve in the Garden. When discontentment exists, sin lies close at hand. What are specific ways you can think of where discontentment became an outward sin that affected you or others? What would you hope to do differently to avoid that in the future?

Of the three things that the sermon notes speak of that discontentment reveals, which do you see most clearly in yourself?

What promises of God do you need to personally have put into the forefront of your mind and heart more often in order to battle discontentment?

Read Matthew 7:11 and 6:25-33. How do these verses affect your contentment in the Lord? Spend some time prayer now praising, repenting, asking and yielding and let the Holy Spirit work in your hearts constantly reminding of His sovereignty and faithfulness.
