START AND END WITH GRACE

In all of Paul's 13 letters he starts with grace, preaches the Gospel of Grace and then ends reminding us of His Grace.

What is Grace? Why is it so amazing? For starters, it's from God the Father.

Grace is the opposite of karma, which is all about getting what you deserve. Grace is getting what you don't deserve, and *not* getting what you do deserve. Christianity teaches that what we deserve is death with no hope of resurrection but what we get is life and life abundantly.

- Grace drives sanctification.
- Genuine transformation doesn't happen overnight.
- It takes time to "grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ"
- But eventually, by His Grace He transforms our desires, motivations, and behavior.
- We live in a world of earning, deserving, and merit, and these result in judgment. That is why everyone wants and needs grace. Judgment kills.

What is Encouragement?

- Biblical encouragement is more than just complimenting someone's new shoes or side dish they brought over. That kind of encouragement is important, but the encouragement the Word refers to is explicitly *Christian* encouragement.
- Pastor Garret Kell of 9 Marks Ministries says that...."Encouragement is shared with the hopes that it will lift someone's heart toward the Lord. It points out evidences of grace in another's life to help them see that God is using them. It points a person to God's promises that assures them that all they face is under His control."

COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Before your group starts, is there anyone who can share the Memory Verse?

Read Philippians 1:2, then Philippians 4:21-23. What stuck out to you from this verse or the message on Sunday?_

Why do you think Paul begins each of his 13 letters with Grace and ends each one of them with grace? Why is it so important? In your own words explain what's so amazing about grace.

Pastor Michael Horton writes...."In grace, God gives nothing less than Himself. Grace, then, is not a third thing or substance mediating between God and sinners, but is Jesus Christ in redeeming action." Now read Galatians 1:3-5. Explain the importance of God giving Himself and how that magnifies His Love and Grace to us.

1 Corinthians 1:10, Titus 2:11, Romans 5:2, 2 Timothy 2:1, Hebrews 4:16, 1 Peter 1:10 and Hebrews 13:9. How does grace motivate us, train us and give us strength for our current daily struggles and trials?

Read 1 Thessalonians 5:11. Then read the definition of encourage under "Encourage with Grace" in the Sermon Notes. What is Christian Encouragement? How can you encourage one another, and who at Life Mission can you encourage?_

Last Sunday Pastor Jobey asked us to think about people who we are going to reach out to and extend God's grace to by the generous giving of time and blessing. Please share with your group the 3 or 4 people that you wrote down that need Jesus. Tell them their names and how you are hoping to reach out to them, whether it's dinner, coffee, etc.

Then end group by praying that the same grace that has reached you, would reach them.
