John 15.1-17

COMMUNITY IS GOD'S IDEA

John 15.1-17

Going back to Genesis, we see that God created Adam and Eve out of the dust of the ground. He could have made it so that every human after that was made the same way. But instead, in wanting us to partake in the joy and beauty of relationship, He created marriage and family, that we would grow *together* in the Gospel, rather than just be isolated created beings.

Your need for help is not a result of the fall, but the fact that you are human. You are not God.

You make decisions not based on the facts, but your interpretation of the facts. And each of us have the potential to interpret the facts wrongly because of our spiritual blindness or distortions because of our sin, idols, and sin done to us.

HOW WILL WE DO IT?

John 15.4-6, 11-13, 17 // 1 Corinthians 12.12-31 // Romans 12.4-8

In another analogy in the Word, as Jesus said the branches must be connected to the Vine, Paul said that individual body parts must be connected to the body. With Christ as the head, an individual body part *must be* connected to the body for it to be effective, alive, and useful.

WE NEED EACH OTHER

The language of the Gospel is primarily plural.

There are countless Scriptures that not only encourage but command us to be humble, vulnerable, teachable, accountable, and seeking out challenge and correction from others.

Hebrews 3.13 // Philippians 1.27, 28 // Hebrews 10.24, 25

COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Before discussion begins, is there anyone who can recite 1 Peter 2:9?

Read John 15. What stuck out to you in these verses or was the most impactful from the message on Sunday?

Community is another way we abide in the vine. Read **Hebrews 3:12-15**. Why do we need Community?

Both in your own abiding and at group read **Proverbs 27:5-6**, then answer questions below. Leaders, plan on leaving most of the time (20-30 minutes) for guys and gals to break up for real, authentic, sin-confessing, Gospel-centered Community. Once everyone has split up, ask the following remaining questions:

1. Who are you accountable to and truly knows you? Who frequently confronts your blind spots and sin? Does the relationship point you to Jesus and the Gospel and help you "put on the armor" for you when it's too heavy and you are too weak? If no one, why not? Not sure how? You lack desire? Where's the road block?

2. When was the last time you asked someone to speak into your life concerning sin and blind spots? When they do, what was your response?

3. Ask these people if they feel comfortable confronting you, or if they avoid it because they either fear you will become angry, defensive, or very hurt.

See below the seven ways that we minimize sin:

- Defending: Do you justify your actions, even using Scripture to do so?
- Faking: Do you put on a different face/image around people than in private?
- Hiding: Do you avoid relationships that call you out?
- Exaggerating: Do you make yourself sound better (or worse) than you are?
- Blaming: Do you bring up the past or others frequently. Do you say, "I'm sorry, but..."
- Downplaying: Do you say, "what's the big deal," or "it's not like I'm [something worse]."
- Comparing: Do you compare yourself to others, for better or worse?

Which of these are you most prone to? Be specific in sharing when you do these.

Do you have unrepentant, ongoing sin that you need to repent of right now? Don't live this way. Repent today, pick up your cross. Jesus forgives His enemies, He will forgive you.

Are you the same person that you are in public as in private? Are you amazed with the Gospel? Be honest of where you are at.

Very important! Leave enough time for this confession along with Gospel reminders through prayer using the P.R.A.Y. model from last week. Read **Romans 8:1** together inserting your name into the verse. Praise God, Preach His Gospel into your co-laborers hearts and minds, Repent of any sin, Ask for your sin idols to be smashed and replaced with Jesus, then Yield with Thanksgiving!
