## ABOVE THE MASTER?

### Matthew 10.24, 25 // 2 Timothy 3.12

"Beelzebul" is another name for Satan, the "prince of demons." Do we subconsciously believe, for whatever reason, that we are above our Master? If He lived and suffered the way He did, what makes us think that we are exempt from that?

Give God glorious thanks that you were born among the reached. But give God glorious sacrifice by living for the unreached.

If you want to grow in a deep, uninhibited passion, a reckless abandon and passionate pursuit of Christ above all things, you MUST be convinced of His sovereignty over everything, you MUST have a vision of our eternal future, and you MUST have a deep belief in the assurance of that future!

## COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Read Matthew 10:24-33. What stuck out to you in these verses or was the most impactful from the message on Sunday?

Who or what should we fear the most? What is your biggest fear: God, someone or something else?

Who is our Sovereign Father (Psalms 135:5-6) calling and appointing to help preach His good news? Who do you really believe is in complete control of your life?

Read Romans 3:24, 2 Corinthians 5:17-19, Romans 5:2, 6:11, 23, 8:1-2, 39, Ephesians 1:3,20, 2:10-13, 3:11, 1 Corinthians 1:30, Ephesians 4:32, 2 Corinthians 1:21 and 1 Peter 1:3-4. In your personal time of abiding, study each Gospel verse and remind yourself of who you are "In Christ."

Realizing and remembering who we are "In Christ" is one of the ways we can combat the fear of rejection, fear of man and fear over situations we can't control. When we remember who we are and believe that the One who has given us the task to reach the unreached is in complete control then we are filled with a rock solid confidence that only comes from the Lord. When you fear, are you reminding yourself of who you are In Christ? Do you spend time abiding and memorizing and rooting yourself to His Word so that you can "preach to yourself" rather than "listen to yourself?"

We have been given a message of Hope for the lost, a message of good news for the brokenhearted. In John 6:60-69 Peter said, "I have nowhere else to go! Where else, what else would you have me do?"

Jobey used an example on Sunday about the Queen Mary being retrofitted for use in battle during WWII. When you survey your life - your time, what you daydream about, how you spend money, what you plan for your future - are you "outfitting" your life more for comfort and convenience, or for battle?

If you don't answer God's call in your life, where else or what else would you do with it? What will you be spending most of your time doing if not devoting your life to His mission? What are some practical ways that you can set yourself up to "live for the unreached?

Do you believe that God has called you to be one of His messengers of the Gospel in this world? Both in your quiet time abiding and in your Community Group, read Psalm 23. Then pray to close the group out using the P.R.A.Y. model.
