JESUS IS STRONGER Matthew 12.22-29

NOTES:

GOD'S DESIRES AND GOD'S WISDOM

Matthew 12.22-29

Many people were seeing Jesus perform these miracles, but they still had their doubts and questions. This is most likely due to His unexpected demeanor and non-militaristic, servant-oriented approach. Remember, even John the Baptist's followers were sent by John to "double check" to see if He was the Messiah.

AN ILLOGICAL CONCLUSION

The Pharisees, who had knowingly been hardening their hearts toward the truth, are now grasping for straws. They now claim that Jesus was a messenger of Satan and was casting out demons by the power of Satan. His answer shows them that their response is both illogical and hypocritical, since no other former miracles or works of God by other Jews ("sons") were declared as "from Beelebul (a.k.a., Satan)."

THE KING IS HERE

Rather, Jesus points out that if He has shown authority over Satan, it's because He is not only stronger than Satan, but He has proven that to show unbridled authority over Satan, Satan must first be bound. Therefore, Jesus points out that He is truly stronger than he, because He has this ability because He has first bound the enemy.

John 1.1-5 // Colossians .13, 14

Jesus didn't come to save us from something we wanted out of; He came to save us from something *He* wanted us out of.

COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Read Matthew 12:22-29. What stuck out to you in these verses or was the most impactful from the message on Sunday?

On Sunday and through these verses we are reminded that one of the reasons Jesus has come is to prove His power over Satan. Explain how knowing, reminding yourself and believing this truth while being tempted gives you power or could give you power to battle against the enemies lies.

Read Matthew 12:28. Where does Jesus get His power to cast out the demons? Why is it so crucially important to know where this power comes from?

In verse 25 Jesus says, "A Kingdom divided will not stand." Division in the Kingdom is never good. The church must be unified, aiming towards the same goals and motives. And even further, we are often divided in our own minds, wanting to serve Satan and our own flesh and desires as well as our God at the same time. This is when our "flesh" is warring against the "Spirit" within us and tempting us to sin. Read Matthew 6:24, James 1:8 and James 4:8. Do you ever struggle with being "double minded" and wanting to serve two masters?

Read Romans 8:11, 1 Corinthians 3:16 and Ezekiel 36:27. We have been given the same Spirit that was given to Jesus! Do you take advantage of this gift or often neglect it? What are some specific and recent examples in your own life of when you neglect it? What are of life could you use prayer and encouragement for in order for you to depend more on the Spirit, rather than your own flesh?

Remind yourself in both your time of abiding and when ending your Community Group of Jesus' power. Pray these verses into your mind and into your heart. Read aloud John 1:3, Colossians 1:16-17, Hebrews 1:3, Isaiah 63:1, for the "P" (Preach the Gospel) part of your prayer in both in your personal time of "abiding" and with your Community Group. When you pray, Preach this passage into your heart and into your mind! Next, confess and Repent of the sin of wanting to "serve" Satan but giving into the enemy's temptations. Ask the Holy Spirit who is with you to help empower you for Godly living. Pray that as His empowered "bruised reed", God would be glorified in your life. Last, end with Thanksgiving and Yield to His will.
