CHILDISH (NOT CHILD-LIKE) FAITH

1 Corinthians 3.1-4

SPIRITUAL IMMATURITY

Paul told the Corinthian church that people who don't believe in Christ aren't able to fully grasp faith because they are not "spiritual" people. But sometimes, there are even *Christians* who don't respond to the message of Jesus. Paul tells the Corinthians, that though they are born again, they are still living "in the flesh," and says they are acting like babies, namely due to their diet and their actions.

Diet: What are you feeding yourself? Hebrews 5.11-13 // 1 Corinthians 13.11 **Actions:** How are you acting? Galatians 5.16-21 // Romans 8.5-11

PATIENCE FOR YOU, PATIENCE FOR OTHERS

Though we are given the Spirit, and the old us has been crucified, there is still work to be done. When we become believers, we often don't put away the idols that we've built our lives out of and cherish in our hearts.

Galatians 2.20 // Romans 8.30 // Philippians 1.6

When Jesus said, "it is finished," He is saying that the work of justification, the promise of sanctification, and the guarantee of glorification has been made sure. In this life, our justification is in the past, our glorification is in the future, and we are living out the present promise of sanctification.

GOOD NEWS FOR US ALL

2 Corinthians 10.3-6 // Philippians 2.12, 13

When Christ died for us, He not only purchased our salvation, but also purchased the gift of the Holy Spirit for you. He then works in you to will and work for God's good pleasure. He guides us into the heart and life changing truth of the Gospel. In time, His Word changes us as it goes to war in our hearts against the flesh.

COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Before your group starts, is there anyone who can share the Memory Verse?

Read 1 Corinthians 3.1-4. What stands out to you in this passage, and what stuck out to you most from the sermon on Sunday? _

It is humbling for us to recognize that we might be considered spiritual infants, or even for mature believers, that we have infant-like areas of our spiritual life. What causes us to remain infant-like in our faith?

Preaching the Gospel to Yourself

Read Galatians 2.20, Romans 8.30, and Philippians 1.6. It is easy for us to feel inferior when we see ourselves as infants, especially when we wrongly compare ourselves to others. What part of the Gospel is found in these verses, and how could memorizing these verses help you to battle against discouragement, apathy, condemnation, and even spiritual laziness, and give you a deeper passion and love for Christ?

Repent and Confess

What diet and actions might point to areas of your life that you are still acting in the flesh? You may want to read Galatians 5.16 and Romans 8.30. In what area of your life do you need to change your diet and hope to see new actions or attitude?

Ask for Provision

In light of these passages, what do you need to ask for from the Lord? Do you need to have some blind spots revealed? Do you recognize areas of weakness that need to be strengthened? Do you need to ask Him for some discipline to take the next small steps of faith by walking with the Spirit who is working in you?

Your Life Mission

Part of living life as Christians who battle against the flesh is that we often walk in fear of man, faithlessness, and discouragement concerning sharing our faith. This is quite normal, even Paul dealt with fear of man! This is why it is so important for us to bear each others' burdens as it pertains to the sharing of our faith. What conversations are coming that you need prayer for? How is your flesh trying to discourage you in those relationships? Have your church family pray for these.

End the evening in a time of prayer, praying through the theme of the night using the P.R.A.Y. model with your group. Make sure to end your time of prayer Yielding with Thanksgiving for God's sovereignty and plan for your life.
