WHAT IS THE GREAT COMMISSION?

Matthew 28.18-20

The Great Commission is not the Great Opportunity or the Great Option. This is our Great Commission, our obligation. God is a Missionary God. He is a sent God, as we've seen, and He is also a sending God. He was sent to save, we have been saved to be sent.

THE COMFORT OF JESUS' AUTHORITY AND POWER

What gives us confidence to go? When Jesus says, "therefore, go," and the use of "therefore" means we can place the word "because" at the beginning of the sentence here. *Because* Jesus has all authority, we can now therefore go by His sending power!

When Jesus says, "I have all authority," He is letting us know that He is no longer the rejected Man acquainted with sorrows. He is the glorious King who has conquered. And because of this, we can with confidence "go" into all the earth to see people saved and disciple by the power of this risen King.

Give God glorious thanks that you were born among the reached. But give God glorious sacrifice by living for the unreached.

Jesus does not call the equipped, He equips the called. And He has said, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, even so I am sending you." (John 20.21)

COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Read through **Matthew 28:16-20**, What impacted you the most from these verses or the message on Sunday?

Read **Matthew 9:37-38**. What role does prayer have in our lives as we go out into the harvest?

Jobey defined the comfort we have in Christ's authority and power and how the sovereignty of God gives us the strength to pick up our cross and go out as sheep among wolves. How does the sovereignty of God give us strength and comfort in fulfilling the Great Commission?

Last week, we looked at the death and resurrection of Christ and how He not only bore the wrath for our sin but He also has credited His righteousness to us. Christ reconciled us back to the Father and because of His work, He has the authority and power to say "And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age" **Matthew 28:20**. In knowing and believing that Christ's work has made it possible for the Holy Spirit to live within us, how does this affect the way we proclaim the Good News?

Read **2 Corinthians 5:18-20**. Knowing that we have been entrusted with the message of reconciliation, what does it mean to be an ambassador for Christ? Do you feel you are fulfilling this role well? If not, what sorts of things paralyze you and prevent you from sharing the Gospel in your daily life?

Read Paul's words in **1 Corinthians 2:1-5**; Can you relate to any of the inadequacies Paul mentions to the people of Corinth? Now read **2 Corinthians 3:4-6**. How are we equipped in our weaknesses

to be ministers of the new covenant?

End group reflecting on how the Holy Spirit lives within you and how God is your sufficiency and strength as you seek to fulfill the Great Commission. Pray together thanking God that He has reconciled you to Himself and has made you an ambassador for Christ and given you the strength to make His glory known among the nations.
