### GODLY LEADERSHIP, A HEALTHY CHURCH

1 Peter 5.1-9

## NOTES:

## WHAT ARE ELDERS?

**Pastors/Shepherds:** The Greek word "poimen" appears 18 times in the NT, which includes 15 times as an actual shepherd, twice to describe Jesus, and once to describe a ministry role. Likewise, 11 times it's used as a verb, with 4 of those times used for spiritual feeding, once as feeding *false* detaching, 4 times to describe rule (usually of Christ), and twice to feed livestock.

The Trinity as the Model: Elders are equal with all members of the body, including Deacons. It is only the role and responsibility that changes, just as how the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are one, yet they have different roles and "responsibilities" in the work of salvation.

Pastor/Elders are to lead primarily through "word" gifts.

### PETER'S EXAMPLE OF HUMBLE LEADERSHIP

**So:** Peter is referring back to earlier context of suffering and holding other believers accountable (**4.17-19**). Pastors are to be held to the highest standard. (**James 3.1**).

Peter relates as a "fellow elder," not as an apostle. He subtly reminds them that he witnessed the suffering of Christ, no doubt invoking memory that upon that witnessing, he actually denied Jesus. Nonetheless, Jesus restored him, and Peter then repeats the restorative words of Jesus now to his readers.

## COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

What stuck out to you the most or was the most impactful from the message on Sunday?

Read 1 Peter 5.1-9. What words or thoughts through these first few verses jump out at you?

Read James 3.1. Why do you think God has a stricter judgment on teachers?

By that verse alone, it's clear that God takes the handling of His Word very seriously. Read **Matthew 7.15-23** and **2 Timothy 4.2-4**. What is most interesting about these false teachers here?

It's one thing to reject the teachings of Buddha or Mohammed, but the Word warns us of people who *look* like they are in line. When you choose to read a book or get advice, how do you ensure that the book or advice is biblical, rather than just *sounding* biblical?

The word "sound" (as in "sound doctrine") in the bible means "healthy." Why is it important to make sure that what you are reading, watching, or listening to is "sound doctrine"? When is a time or season in your Christian life that you were being "fed" or believed false teaching? How did it change and what was the result?

Read Hebrews 13.17. What sticks out to you in this verse?

At the end of the verse, it says that *not* submitting to spiritual leaders would not be beneficial for us. Why do you think it's a disadvantage to be unsubmitted?

God created us to be in community, and He has given gifts in the form of pastors, teachers, etc. (Ephesians 4.11-16) to shepherd, teach, and feed us. Without sound teaching, the ideals of the world and our own sinful desires would ruin us.

Hearing and believing "sound doctrine" is crucial for growth. Without it, we will have unhealthy spiritual lives. What is an area or areas of your life that you think you need to learn or grow in so that you can get more healthy as a Christian?

Seek out some counsel or advice on how you can grow in that area by taking in good, sound teaching that can help reshape and reform your heart and mind.
