COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Read Matthew 24.14. What in this verse or from the sermon Sunday stuck out to you the most, and why?
This week's discussion centers around the Kingdom of God. When we come to Christ we come under His rule to serve Him and His kingdom. However, we are bombarded with all kinds of messages from the world around us that express a value system that runs contrary to Christ's. How do we maintain and protect our Kingdom focus?
What is the kingdom of God?
Jesus said in Mark 10.15 , "I tell you the truth, anyone who will not receive the Kingdom of God like a little child will never enter it." What does it mean to receive the Kingdom like a little child?
Jesus said we are to seek the Kingdom. How do we lose sight of the Kingdom, and what will draw us away?
Jesus said in John 18.36 , "My kingdom is not of this world." What did He mean?
What place does the Kingdom of God play in your life? What does it mean for you to be in His Kingdom?
Read Matthew 13.1-23 . Ask the Lord to show you what kind of soil you are. Examine your life and how it lines up with God's Kingdom. What are you giving your time, energy and money to? That is what will indicate whether it is God's or man's kingdom that your focus is on.
