Matthew 13.1-9, 18-23

### FOUR TYPES OF SOIL

Matthew 13.1-9, 18-23

**The Sower:** Jesus (Also Possibly a Believer as Christ Works Through Them)

The Seed: the Gospel
The Soil: Human Hearts

Of these three elements, the Sower (Jesus) and the Seed (the Gospel) don't change. They are stable, they are whole and unbroken. However the Soil (Human Hearts) are the variable.

**Soil #1:** Hears the Good News but it's immediately rejected because the enemy has deceived. The person has already decided to believe "another gospel" and refuses to budge.

**Soil #2:** Hears the Word and has a "positive religious experience," and even endures for a while (even years), taking part in religious activity. But eventually they leave the faith and reject Christ by either word or deed, or both.

**Soil #3:** Hears the Word and understands, and to some point even acknowledges or agrees in some aspects of its truthfulness, but makes a decision instead to follow after the cares of the world.

**Soil #4:** Hears the truth of the Gospel and really believes. Their hearts are converted from inside and their life subsequently changes for the long haul.

# WHICH SOIL ARE YOU?

1 John 2.3-6 // 1 John 2.19 // 2 Corinthians 13.5

How do we know if we are really believers who have been adopted by God our Father? There will be a consistent and long term (even if slow) growing of both inward fruit and outward fruit, as well as a continual diminishing of inward bad fruit and outward bad fruit.

But this is tricky, especially when we are dealing with others. Ultimately, we cannot judge whether someone is truly a believer. They may have little to no fruit, but we know that this passage tells us that we all bear fruit in different amounts, and we also know that there are such things as prodigal sons.

Don't assume the best, but don't judge for the worse.

Pray for a broken heart.

At the end of the day, we trust that both Jesus and the Gospel will work sovereignly. Our job is to be faithful as ministers of reconciliation.

# COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Read Matthew 13:1-9, 18-23. What stuck out to you the most or was the most impactful from the message on Sunday or from these verses? Who is the sower in the story? What's the seed? What's the soil? Read 1 John 2:19 and 2 Corinthians 13:5. How can you tell whether or not you have fallen amongst good soil? In other words, how do you know that you are truly a believer? We know that some people will produce bountiful fruit, that is, recognizable to everyone, while other may produce more subtle, slow growing, fruit. Both are good! Are you producing fruit? Share some of the fruit that God is producing in your life currently. Share recent or current examples of both inner and outer fruit. Read Matthew 13:18-23 again. Unfortunately, we all know people who fit into each of these categories. There is often a fine line however between those whose seed falls amongst thorns and those that fall amongst good soil. What can you do to ensure that you're caring for the "soil" of your heart? Read Matthew 28:16-20. After the resurrection of Jesus, we receive the Great Commission. As we see in 1 Corinthians 3:5-9, we now become the sower (since we are ambassadors of Christ) and are responsible for casting seed and providing the water. Ultimately, one's salvation falls back on the sovereignty of God. We are simply called to be obedient. So, how and to whom are you sowing? Are you casting seed at home with your spouse? Your kids? At work? With friends? How do you "water"? Read Proverbs 4:20-23, 2 Timothy 4:2-5, Hebrews 4:12-13, and Colossians 3:12-17. Do you hesitate to share the Gospel with unbelievers? How about believers who need a reminder? What stops you? What does this reveal about your heart, and what can you do initiate change?

Lastly, pray as a group using the P.R.A.Y. model. Pray for an increased desire for the Word of God, prayer, and Gospel community, so that the seed that God has cast may be continually watered and find healthy soil in your heart.
