Exodus 20.8-11, 34.20

WHAT IS SABBATH REST?

Exodus 20.8-11, 34.20

IN the Old Testament, the Sabbath was a day the Lord specifically designed in the Hebrew week so that they would get proper rest; a day of corporate worship, rest, recreation, feasting, and enjoyment of others in a way that brings God glory. Thought Christ fulfilled the Law, the New Testament shows us that the new "Sabbath day of rest" was transferred to Sunday, the day Jesus rose, and became the day that the church would enjoy their Sabbath rest with each other.

Mark 2.27

The Sabbath is a gift to us, but also a test for us. A test to trust God's work more than our own.

TRUSTING HIM MORE THAN OURSELVES

Somewhere along the road, something happened to Sabbath rest. Rest became luxury, Sunday became just another day, and church life, corporate worship, and commitment to the body became optional. Priorities need reset.

Rest: Sleep is a dedicated time we trust the Lord. We are literally helpless, and sleep reminds us that we are not God. It says to ourselves and God, "I'm not You, so I trust you. My world will be okay without me." Don't be tied to your work in a way that it prevents you from God's wisdom and desires for you to rest, particularly in the context of corporate worship and spiritual refreshment. Making the hard choice to rest in a busy, demanding life is choosing to trust God for His sovereign provision.

Matthew 16.26 // Hebrews 10.24, 25

Recreation: Though recreation and relaxation alone won't bring you ultimate joy, they can be used by God to relieve tension, stress, and a clouded heart. When that pathway is cleared, it allows a straight path for the Gospel.

JESUS, OUR TRUE SABBATH REST

Matthew 11.28-30 // Isaiah 40.28-31

We do not have to keep the Law because Christ fulfilled it all. The way we truly keep the Sabbath is by resting in Him. *Every day* we can find Sabbath rest when we look to Him, and He graciously gives us wise means to help us prioritize for the purpose of our joy and satisfaction in Him.

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COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Before group, see if anyone can recite this week's memory verse. 1 John 4:10

Read **Exodus 20:8-11** and **34:20**. What was most impactful from the sermon on Sunday or stuck out to you in these verses?

Read John 15:4 and Psalm 95:2-3. What distractions or busyness in life are keeping you away from coming to Jesus in awe, wonder and amazement? What is a great antidote to busyness and distractions?

Read Luke 38-42. How do you relate to Martha, who was so distracted with busyness that she missed the main point of simply worshipping, abiding and spending time at the feet of Jesus?

Read **Matthew 11:28-30**. Speaking of verse 28, Pastor Matt Chandler says Jesus is saying, "Hey, if you're exhausted, if you're bitter, if you're lonely, if you're angry, if you struggle, if you are socially inept, if you have no people skills, if you can't figure it out, come here. If you are tired, weary, come here. Are you a train wreck? Come here. Are you broken? Are you stuck in lust? Angry? Fearful? Get over here. What an invitation!" And then there is an exchange: Jesus says, "come to me, even with your (fill in the blank) and I'll give you rest." What or who do you "go to" for rest for your weary soul? Does it give you life? Does it refresh you?

On Sunday Pastor Jobey said that a hobby should provide a means for you to unwind and relax from the activities that otherwise consume your time and dominate your mind. Think through your hobbies, answer the following questions:

- Does your hobby feed your soul with God exalting experiences?
- Are you being enlightened and empowered for Christ, or are you becoming more in love with the world and the hobby itself for the hobby's sake?
- Does it refresh you emotionally, etc., for other parts of life and ministry?
- Or does it deplete you and take away from the more important things?
- Are you involving others in it? What is the purpose of this hobby?
- What do you gain from it? Can you thank God for it and can you confidently say, "I can do this for the glory of God"?

End group and your personal study time with prayer. Pray using the **P.R.A.Y.** model. **Preach** the Gospel, reminding one another of the beauty of Jesus, who gives ultimate joy and happiness to those who seek Him. Confess and **Repent** of any sin blocking you from experiencing joy. Then **Ask** for the Holy Spirit, who is your Helper and with you to continue to increase your joy. Ask Him to help you turn to prayer more, the Word more and your Gospel-centered friends. Lastly, **Yield**, with thanksgiving.
