## WHY DO WE NEED TO BE FILLED WITH THE SPIRIT?

Matthew 10.16-20 // John 17.18

To take up our cross and be effective witnesses and ministers, we must be clothed with power from on high. Power to witness and fulfill the Great Commission is only done by the empowering of the Spirit.

Luke 24.49 // Acts 1.4-8, 2.1, 4.8, 31, 7.55, 13.9, 52 // Ephesians 5.18

The Holy Spirit gives gifts to be used for God's glory and to reveal Jesus to a blind world. But we need His empowerment for those gifts to be used with power and effectiveness that is beyond ourselves.

## COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

What stuck out to you the most or was the most impactful from the message on Sunday?
How much would you say you really depend on the Holy Spirit, and what does that look like in your life?
When you think through the roles you have in life, be it as a parent, a spouse, a friend, or serving in church, have you experienced that in a way where you feel like you've been "filled with the Spirit" to perform certain elements or tasks?
Read <b>Acts 4.8.</b> Here, Peter is filled with the Spirit to preach a powerful sermon. Though it's not explicit, we would suspect that Peter gave many effective sermons in his life, but this seems to point out that the Holy Spirit "filled the balloon" a bit more for this one. Now read <b>Matthew 10.16-20.</b> How does Peter's experience relate to what Jesus said in these verses? And what implications does that have in your life?
When it comes to serving, sharing our faith, or committing to spiritual things, it's usually selfishness, fear of man or failure, or a lack of passion and conviction that keeps us from stepping out in those areas. Which of these (or something else) is it for you?
Here are some verses (among so many others!) that are close to my heart that I remind myself when fear (my crippler) grips me: Exodus 4.10-13, Jeremiah 1.4-10, Ephesians 2.10, 1 Timothy 1.6-14, 1 Corinthians 15.10, 2 Corinthians 12.9, 10. Read these and then read Luke 24.49, Acts 1.4-8, and Philippians 4.13. In what areas of life do you need increased faith to first of all, believe that God has called and appointed you to these areas of life, and secondly, believe that He can empower you to do them beyond your ability?
When we begin to believe the promises of God, like the ones above, usually the Holy Spirit will reveal the bigness of God's grace toward us, followed by an increased realization that we don't deserve it. This should lead to repentance. Where is the Spirit leading you right now in your heart as you consider the things you need to repent of?
Now ask Him to fill you afresh with Himself in order to accomplish the area you are in need of. It would be good to split up into smaller groups of 2 or 3 within your

Believe in faith that God loves to give good gifts and that He wants you to learn dependence on Him. Make this a daily habit as you go through all that life brings.
