TO LIVE IS CHRIST, TO DIE IS GAIN

Philippians 1.18b-26

Paul has made Jesus to be his central focus in his life. Because of that, this means that when he dies, it can only get *better* because he will be face to face with Jesus! And it is this very attitude that draws the attention and amazement of others. What do you do with someone who is not easily phased by even death itself!

God is most glorified in us when we are most satisfied in Him.

We draw attention to what satisfies us. We magnify what satisfies us. Most of us fear death because it means the end of what satisfies us, and the end of what we are living for.

WHERE IS YOUR HEAVEN?

Many people, even believers, don't actually look forward to heaven. There are things here and now that they want to do or accomplish or experience. This is due to a lack of really knowing the depth and beauty of Jesus.

You will not see the "gain" of the next life if you do not see the beauty of Jesus in this life.

The word Paul uses for "depart" is a nautical term. It's used to describe when a boat is unmoored from the dock. Death for the believer means setting sail for the ultimate destination, not held down by the limitations of this life, but set free.

YOUR LIFE MISSION

Are you living just to make a living? Or are you living to make a life?

What is your life mission? What is the goal? And what is the plan to get there? What are you living for? And...what does death mean for your mission?

Mark 8.36

The cost of discipleship is great. But the cost of non-discipleship is far greater.

There is a great cost if we choose to live a casual, empty routine, nominal type Christianity. Our joy will be robbed, God's glory will be robbed, and the salvation of other's who need the voice of the church will be robbed.

COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Before your group starts, ask if anyone is able to recite the memory verse.

Read through **Philippians 1:18b-26**. Share some of your thoughts on the passage and the sermon from Sunday.

In reading over Paul's words of being content in life in serving others for the sake of the Gospel or in death and being in the presence of Christ, it is evident Paul magnifies what brings him true joy. With Christ as his hope and foundation in life and death, Paul can joyfully say Christ is his everything. If you were to examine your own life and consider Paul's words "To live is _____, to die is _____," how would you fill in the phrase?

Where is your heaven? What do you pursue and "live for"?

Read **Matthew 6:19-21**. As we look forward to heaven and long to be in the presence of our Heavenly Father, how can we daily align our hearts to treasure Him for who He is and exalt His will in our lives? Are there specific things that we treasure each day that misalign our hearts from laying up treasures in heaven?

In order to daily treasure Christ above all else in our lives, it is vital that we have a strategy or a mission to consistently accomplish that goal. Take some time to write out or describe your own mission statement.


When others look at your life, would they agree with this mission statement? How might they re-write it?

Read **Mark 8:36**. In accomplishing this personal mission statement for our lives and understanding the cost of neglecting Christ, how can we seek to consistently model to nonbelievers what it means to treasure Christ above all things? How can we share the unfailing hope we have in Him both in life and death?

Reflect and pray that in all things, Christ would be magnified and glorified through you. Ask God to teach you what it means to see the beauty of Christ in this life so you may see the gain of the next life. Lastly, ask God what it looks like to share the joy and beauty of Christ with those you know who have no hope in life or death. Consider breaking up into smaller groups, or between men and women, and praying more specifically for each other.
