GIANT FAITH VS. GENUINE FAITH

Matthew 17.14-27

JESUS HEALS BECAUSE WE CAN'T

Matthew 17.14-27 // Mark 9.14-29

It's important to be clear that though there are times in the Word that show sickness is either caused or compounded by demonic activity, sickness is not always the result of the enemy's doing.

QUANTITY VS. QUALITY

On one hand, Jesus says they couldn't cast out the demon because they had "little faith." But then He says if they had faith "the size of a mustard seed," which is, really, "little faith," they could remove mountains. So which is it? The first "little" He is meaning little quality. Their faith was not substantial because their faith was in the wrong object. It was in themselves, not in Christ. The second "little" is quantity. Jesus says you don't need a lot of faith, but you need just even a little genuine faith: faith that is wholly dependent on Him.

We don't need giant faith; genuine faith will do.

In this story, the father of the boy confesses that he does in fact have faith, but he fully acknowledges that he also lacks faith. He believes, quality wise, but has little faith, quantity wise. This is why He comes to Jesus. He knows that Jesus alone can do this.

WHAT ONLY GOD CAN DO

Ephesians 2.10 // Jeremiah 1.4-9

Jesus mentions that there are things that occur in life that come about simply and only by prayer. In other words, we are completely helpless and unable to make them happen. This takes us stepping out in faith and entrusting ourselves to Him, even if it is just a small amount of aenuine faith.

Jesus does not call the equipped, He equips the called.

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COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Read Matthew 17:14-27. What stuck out to you the most in these verses or was the most impactful from the message on Sunday?
What does it take to see God do the amazing in our life?
What is it you are doing in your life that can only be brought about by genuine faith? That can be brought about by prayer?
What would you do with your life if you knew you couldn't fail, if money wasn't an issue? What's the road block, the "why" that stops you from pursuing it?
Read Ephesians 2:10. What changes in your pursuit of what God wants you to pursue in life when you read these verses?
Read Jeremiah 1:4-9. Where does Jeremiah initially put his faith? And what is God's response?
If the Lord called to you or challenged you to pursue what you wrote above, what would your response be?
What do you think His response to you be?
Read Hebrews 13:21 . How does this verse reveal to us what God's response would be to us?

End group and your personal study time with prayer. Pray using the P.R.A.Y. model. PREACH the Gospel, reminding one another of the beauty of Jesus, who satisfies all needs, wants and desires. Confess and repent of perhaps not having enough faith to do God-sized things. Then ASK for the Holy Spirit, who is your Helper and with you to continue to increase your faith. Ask Him to help you turn to prayer more, the Word more and your Gospel-centered friends. Lastly, YIELD, with thanksgiving.
