Matthew 18.5-14

DEALING SEVERELY WITH SIN

Matthew 18.5-9

Jesus is speaking hyperbolically here, showing the intensity and severity of how we should battle sin. He goes to a striking place, visually, when showing us clearly that that sin problem isn't "out there," but the sin problem is "in here," within our own hearts and minds.

We've got to be willing to be just as violent against our sin As our sin is willing to be violent against us.

James 1.14, 15

<u>WHEN WE CAN'T SEE</u>

Proverbs 27.5, 6

Sometimes, however, we don't see our own sin, and so we go astray. We fall prey to the deceptiveness of sin when we don't see our own blind spots. Jesus here gives us a picture of God's charge to us, His people, that as He goes after the stray sheep, so should we.

We think we know ourselves best, but our hearts deceive us.

Who frequently confronts you in your blind spots and in your sin? When they do, what is your reaction? Do people feel comfortable confronting you in sin?

REAL FRIENDSHIPS

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COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Read Matthew 18:5-14, what stuck out to you the most in these verses or was the most impactful from the message on Sunday?

In Matthew 18:8-9, Jesus draws radical attention to the need for us to address our own sin and remove it. What do we need to address to effectively remove a particular sin from our life?

Read Galatians 5:19-21, James 1:15, and 1 John 3:6-10. Do you ever ask God to reveal sin to you? How do you address your sin issues? In other words, are you "killing your sin," and if so, what are you doing to expose and kill your sin? ____

Have you participated in a "Fight Club" (one on one time as you "fight for the truth of the Gospel") with a friend or another member of the group recently? If so, has your experience been positive or negative? Why is that? If not, what is holding vou back?

Read Matthew 18:12-13 again. Who in your life is like the sheep who has gone astray? How can/is God using you to search for that "lost sheep?"

Read Psalm 139:7-12, 16, Proverbs 16:33, Philippians 2:13, and Colossians 1:15-16, and Have you ever been the lost sheep? How has God used you going astray to bring Him more alory?

End group and your personal study time with prayer. Pray using the P.R.A.Y. model, PREACH the Gospel, reminding one another of the beguty of Jesus, who satisfies all needs, wants and desires. Confess and repent of any blind spots that have been recently exposed or are being exposed. Then ASK for the Holy Spirit, who is your Helper and with you to continue to increase your faith. Ask Him to help you turn to prayer more, the Word more and your Gospel-centered friends. Lastly, YIELD, with thanksgiving.
