Philippians 3.1-11 Part 2

WE DON'T NEED NO STINKING BADGES

Paul makes it clear that anything outwardly done, specifically here he mentions circumcision, is not what makes one righteous. It is not anything outward that makes a person a true believer. But it is our default to run to moralism and self-righteousness.

Romans 2.28, 29 // Deuteronomy 10.15, 16, 30.6

The bible says that real salvation comes from God circumcising our hearts. It is inward, not outward. The problem for us with that is that circumcising our hearts is impossible!

SALVATION BY GOOD WORKS

Legalism is when we *functionally* believe that salvation is actually by works, and is kept by works. We may not say that or believe it deep down, but we think and act with that in our mind. This is what keeps the legalist aiming to do their best. And in many ways, it is a correct belief. Salvation has *always* been by works, going back to the Garden. This is why self-righteousness as a means for salvation is actually bad news. We are unable to rightly achieve salvation. Therefore we need a Savior to put our faith in.

John 6.35-37 // 2 Corinthians 5.21

WE ARE ONE IN CHRIST, LIVING BY FAITH

Justified is not just simply saying we are forgiven.

- It's like saying it's "just as if I'd" never done it, as well as...
- "Just as if I'd" always obeyed.

Satan says: Look at your sin. God says: Look at my Son

This means that your identity, 100%, is not in yourself. Your righteousness, your acceptance, your worthiness comes through faith in Christ by being found in Him. Others may expect more from you, you may expect more from yourself, but when God your Father looks upon your life, He sees His Son.

Ephesians 2.11-22 // Galatians 2.20, 21, 6.14, 15

Together, we all, from the far reaching missionaries to the struggling new believers, are called children, we all have the same access by the same Spirit, and we are all joined together and are growing and being built together.

So when the devil throws your sins in your face and declares that you deserve death and hell, tell him this: "I admit that I deserve death and hell, what of it? For I know One who suffered and made satisfaction on my behalf. His name is Jesus Christ, Son of God, and where He is there I shall be also! - Martin Luther

COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Before group starts, is there anyone who can recite the week's memory verse?

Read **Philippians 3:1-11**. What impacted you the most from this Scripture or from Sunday's message?

We continue the notion of outer works being like badges of merit and accomplishment, and how circumcision was one of the main "badges" that Jews would point to. Read **Romans 2.28**, **29**, and **Galatians 6.14**, **15**. What are the ramifications of these texts? How does this affect the way we look at our own outer good works?

On Sunday, Jobey mentioned that salvation is truly still "by works." In your own words, how is this still true, even though the Word clearly teaches that salvation is "by grace, through faith"?

Read **Romans 3.9-12.** So what then does Paul say about the Jews' (and Gentiles') pursuit of earning salvation through self-righteousness?

Read **Galatians 2.20, 21.** These verses hold the solution to the "salvation by works" problem. In your own words, what does it mean to live your life by faith in the Son of God?

How would you describe your faith? Use as many adjectives or descriptive words you would like. Some might say strong, weak, faltering, mature, difficult, solid, growing, awful, vibrant, disciplined, messy, empty, abundant, invigorating or heavy. You might think of phrases or words like condemnation, judgment, failure, hard hearted, fearful, confused, emotional, or inconsistent.

What are some evidences of God's grace you've seen in your life? In other words, changes or growth you've recently had? What are struggles and sin you have recently faced?

Regardless of what you wrote, you can count all of it (even the good things) as rubbish. None of it counts as far as your acceptance and legitimacy is concerned. Have people break off in smaller groups to pray for each other. Pray for each others' identity in Christ to grow, and for their ability to trade their rubbish for the Bread of Life.
