GOD'S SOVEREIGNTY/HUMAN RESPONSIBILITY

Philippians 2.12-14

WORK OUT OUR SALVATION?

We are not what we ought to be, nor are we what we will be some day. But by God's grace we are not what we used to be!

Firstly, we can be thankful for what God has already done for us as believers. But he is also not done with us. Now, because we are alive in Christ, we have the power to work out and exercise what He has put in us.

Paul does *not* say to "work *for'* salvation, but to work "out" your salvation. Your salvation, as in, a salvation you already have.

GOD'S SOVEREIGNTY AND HUMAN RESPONSIBILITY

It is important to see that it is God who works *first*. He has the plan, He creates, enacts, and first produces the muscle. He loves first, not us. That said...

God's work does not exclude your action, it empowers your action.

1 John 4.19 // Hebrews 13.20, 21 // 1 Corinthians 15.10 // Galatians 3.5

God is 100% responsible for His work of empowering grace. You are 100% responsible to respond to that empowering grace.

TRUSTING GOD MEANS ENTRUSTING TO HIS WAYS

Trusting God does not just mean trusting His character and who He is, but also trusting His ways. Entrusting ourselves to His instructions and commands.

God's sovereignty is NOT separated from His ways.

John 15.16

God calls upon us and commands us to trust in His revealed will and desires for His glory as we exercise our trust in Him. He wants us to be *part of* the miracle we are seeking. The good news for us who are weak, is that God has already put in us what we need, and He gives us the power through the Spirit to work out the faith He has given. As we keep our eyes on Christ, the awe, fear, and wonder of His beauty will continually motivate us to entrust ourselves to our faithful Creator.

COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Before group starts, is there anyone who can recite this week's memory verse?

Read Philippians 2:12-14. What did God show you through His word and through the sermon on Sunday?

What does the fact that Paul is writing to believers show us what he is NOT saying in the text?

How do we work out this gift of salvation?

Can you think of ways in which your salvation has been worked out, stretched, or made stronger recently through specific instances or circumstances or choices?

Read Ephesians 2:10 and John 15:16. Does knowing that God has initiated everything change how we view this working out of our salvation? How should this motivate us?

We have been given the gift of salvation and now we get to be active and work it out with fear and trembling as we focus our hearts and attention on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith. God doesn't get the glory and praise He deserves when we leave this gift untouched and when we let it sit. How can we make sure that we do not become complacent in our salvation and content with where we are at in our walk with God?

What areas of your life have you been just "hoping for a miracle" or passively "waiting on the Lord," when you could be actively involved in "being the miracle" by acting in faith, entrusting yourself to God's ways?

Like the "Lord, bless these donuts to my body" example, which ways of God have you been ignoring? In other words, are you asking Him to bless your marriage, but your work is the priority? Are you asking Him to provide financially, but you are not giving to His mission through the church? We can't just sit around and wait for God to do everything for us. We must have an active part in the working out of our salvation. Pray that God would give us a desire to work out His ways rather than our own ways and ask God to show you how He wants you to be working out your faith and trusting in Him.
